Common Error Messages

Error Message, its Meaning, How to Fix it?

Error No. 1: "You should pay the registration fees and any previous debt before registering in the current semester and pay the Registration Fees First from the Financial Section and check the registration calendar"

It Means: You either have not paid the semester registration fees, OR you still have pending/unsettled debts in your student financial accounts.

How to Fix it?

Please make sure that you have paid the registration fees and any pending / unsettled amounts before attempting to register for courses.



Error No. 2: "Student cannot register course XXX because it has a co-requisite. Msg: Co-requisite violation"

It Means: You are trying to register for a course that has a co-requisite (Both courses should be taken together in the same semester).

How to Fix it?

Please check your Academic Plan and see what is the co-requisite course to the one you are trying to add. Add the co-requisite course first, then the course XXX.



Error No. 3: "Student cannot register course XX because it has a pre-requisite. Msg: Pre-requisite violation"

It Means: You are trying to register for a course that has a pre-requisite (A course that should be passed before the course you are trying to add).

How to Fix it?

Please check your Academic Plan and see what is the pre-requisite course to the one you are trying to add. Register for the pre-requisite course, instead.



Error No. 4: "No more places in section xxxx"

It Means: You are trying to register for a session that is Full (Session has reached the maximum number of registered students).

How to Fix it?

Please try adding another sessions that is not Full and matches your class schedule timing.



Error No. 5: "Student Cannot register section xxxx due to conflicts with course YYY"

It Means: You are trying to register for a session xxxx that causes a conflict in your current schedule with the session of registered course YYY (Adding a session that has the same day and time of a registered one).

How to Fix it?

Please try adding another session of the course you are trying to register for or change the session of the one that has already been added, to avoid class conflict.



Error No. 6: "Please complete advising before registering courses"

It Means: You have more than one academic warning (which means your GPA has been lower than 2 for more than one semester) which placed you on Academic Probation.

How to Fix it?

Please Contact your assigned Academic Advisor to give you the needed advice and to enable the right offered courses for you to register.



Error No. 7: "Student cannot register course XXX because he will exceed maximum load per semester"

It Means: You are trying to register for more than the maximum credit hours that are allowed for you which is 21 CH (or 16 CH for students with Warnings) – Or 12 CH in Summer Semester.

How to Fix it?

Please abide by the number of credit hours that are allowed for you to sustain your academic standing.



Error No. 8: "Student cannot register section ZZZZ because he will exceed maximum allowed University Requirements/Electives in his Academic Plan"

It Means: You have already finished all your University Requirements/Electives courses in your Academic Plan.

How to Fix it?

Please check your Academic Plan to make sure you have finished studying all required University Requirements/Electives courses, and try adding other courses, instead.
